Jeff Greenwald, M.A., M.F.T. is a nationally recognized sport psychology consultant. He is also a licensed family therapist and author of *The Best Tennis of Your Life* and Amazon's best-selling double audio, *Fearless Tennis: The 5 Mental Keys to Unlocking Your Potential*. He holds a Master's Degree in clinical psychology with a specialization in sport psychology from John F. Kennedy University. Jeff is an adjunct professor for graduate students in sport psychology.

Jeff works with numerous pro, college, junior and recreational athletes around the world on the mental game and is on the speaking bureau with Wilson Sporting Goods. As a player, Jeff was ranked #1 in the world by the ITF and No.1 in the United States in singles and doubles by the USTA in 2002.

Feisal, a USPTA Master Professional, is the Director of Certification & Testing for the USPTA Middle States division, and holds USPTA specialist degrees in Competitive Player Development, Facility Management and Little Tennis. He is also a USTA Recreational Coach National and Quickstart Trainer, a member of the National Cardio Tennis Speakers Team and the USPTA National Education Committee and co-chairs the USPTA National Diversity Committee.

Feisal was also voted in Tennis Industry magazine's prestigious "40 Under 40" list for being one of the top 40 men and women under 40 years old who have had and will continue to have a strong influence in the sport and in the business of tennis- both nationally and internationally.

Hassan was named the USPTA Mid-Atlantic Pro of the Year in 2008, 2006, 2004, 1999-1998, 1997-1996, the 2002 USPTA Middle States Pro of the Year, the 1999 USPTA Mid-Atlantic Tester of the Year, the 2009, 2007 and 1998 USPTA Virginia Pro of the Year, the 2008, 2002 and 2001 Middle States Tester of the Year. In addition, Hassan received the 1999 National USPTA Industry Excellence Award, Hassan was also a recipient for the 2003 USPTA National Education Merit Award and a recipient for the 2008, 2006, 2005, 2002 and 2000 National top-10 point holder in USPTA's Career Development.

Ajay is the National Tennis Director for Midtown Athletic Clubs/Tennis Corporation of America (TCA). He is also the Director of Tennis for Midtown Athletic Club in Rochester, New York. Ajay has been with Tennis Corporation of America since 1993 and has served as Head Tennis Professional, Club Manager and General Manager for TCA clubs in the Chicago and Kansas City area.

Pant is also certified as a Master Professional by the USPTA. He was recognized as a "Specialist in Competitive Player Development" in 2001. He was awarded the USPTA/Missouri Valley Facility Manager Of The Year for 2006.

Ajay has successfully completed Level I and Level II of the USTA Sports Science Exams. He was selected by the USTA for the Elite High Performance Coaching Program in 2000 and is a USTA Recreation Coaches Workshop Master Trainer. Ajay is the recipient of the USTA/Missouri Valley President's award for 2007.

Joseph Thompson, a USPTA Master Professional with nearly 36 years of service, continues his long-term commitment to the future of both the game and the tennis-teaching family.

This 1998 recipient of the Alex Gordon Award for USPTA National Professional of the Year has been a member of the association since 1976. A member of USPTA's national board of directors since 1992, Joe served as President of USPTA for 3 consecutive terms (1999-2003, longer than anyone in the history of the association), and currently serves as Past President, and chairman of the Master Professional committee on the Executive Board.

Joe has been the director of tennis at Rolling Hills Country Club in Golden, Colorado for the past 30 years. He also is active in USPTA's Intermountain Division.

Kathy Woods is the co-author of *Playing Tennis After 50* with her husband Ron, published by Human Kinetics. She is the Director of Tennis at the highly regarded Racquet Club of St. Petersburg. A USPTA certified teaching professional for 30 years; Kathy has directed tennis programs in Princeton, N.J. Key Biscayne, FL; and Westport, CT.

Kathy served as President of the United States Professional Tennis Association (USPTA) from 1994 to 1996, the first and only female to serve the association in that capacity.

In 1996, Kathy was honored with the prestigious Educational Merit Award by the International Tennis Hall of Fame for outstanding service in tennis at the national level.

Ron Woods, Ph.D. is a performance coach for the Human Performance Institute in Orlando, Florida, and an adjunct professor of sport science at the University of South Florida and the University of Tampa.

He is the author of *Playing Tennis After 50* with his wife, Kathy, *Energy Every Day* with Chris Jordan and *Social Issues in Sport*, all published by Human Kinetics.

He served the United States Tennis Association for nearly 20 years as the first director of player development and then director of community tennis programs.

Ron received the Educational Merit award by the International Tennis Hall of Fame in 1997, was honored by USPTA as national Coach of the Year in 1982 and designated as a master professional in 1984.
